

OSCE stations of introductory course 2017

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First day:

1. take history from a patient with hematemesis.
2. inspect abdomen and test for ascites.
3. physical examination for knee effusion.
4. take history to differentiate between stable and unstable angina.
5. inspect and palpate posterior chest.

Second day:

1. take a history from a patient with chronic cough of 3 months duration.
2. palpate and percuss the abdomen.
3. test motor function of lower limb.
4. palpate and percuss posterior chest.
5. take a history from patient with red urine.
